

# CAMPAIGN TO **BAN** TROPHY HUNTING



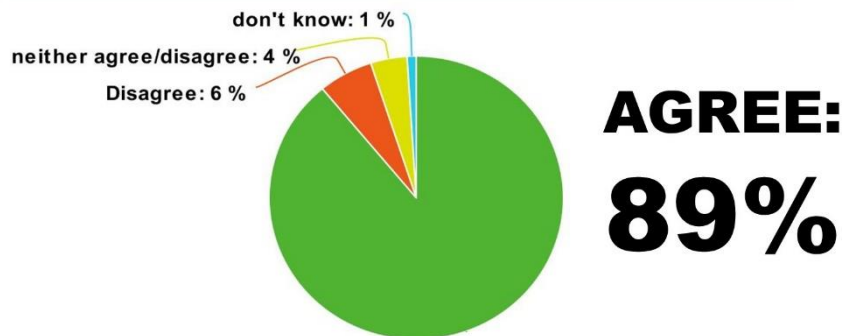
## What do Conservative voters think about Trophy Hunting?

- The government pledged to ban imports of hunting trophies in the Oct 2019 Queens Speech.
- In December 2019, the Conservative Party election manifesto included a promise to ban imports of hunting trophies from “endangered” species.
- There is a proposal under consideration to exempt some hunting trophies from a ban if the hunter pays a ‘blood money’ fee when shooting the animal.

A recent opinion poll carried out by Survation of 1,020 respondents found that:

- [Conservative voters](#) are strongly supportive of an **IMMEDIATE** ban on trophy imports
- [Conservatives](#) want a **TOTAL** ban, not just one limited to endangered species
- [Conservatives](#) are strongly **OPPOSED** to any ‘Blood Money’ loophole.

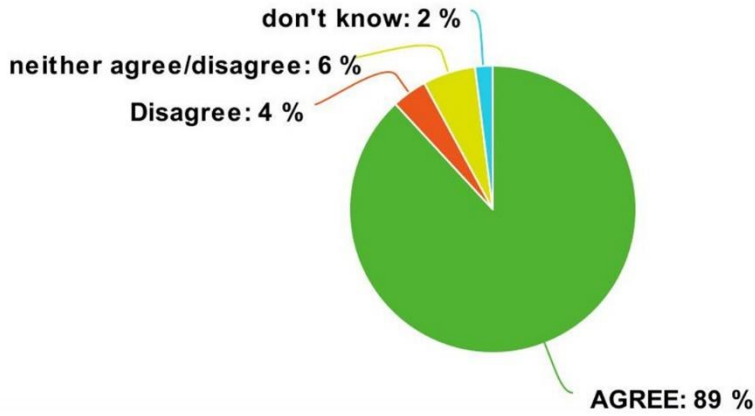

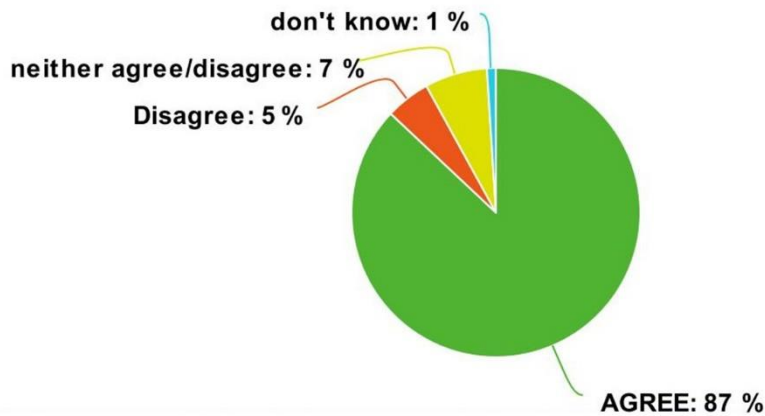
## 89% of Conservative voters want a TOTAL Ban on Hunting Trophies
